

Campus Citizenship Program

High Desert School operates under ten school-wide rules. Each teacher may have a maximum of 3 additional rules to facilitate a safe and productive environment in his classroom. Every High Desert student begins each quarter with 100 merits or an "A+" grade in campus citizenship. Should a student decide to not follow a school rule, merits are subtracted. The citizenship grade is computed for the trimester report cards on the following scale.

90 - 100 merits remaining at the end of the grading period	= "A" Campus Citizenship Grade
80 - 89 merits remaining at the end of the grading period	= "B" Campus Citizenship Grade
70 - 79 merits remaining at the end of the grading period	= "C" Campus Citizenship Grade
60 - 69 merits remaining at the end of the grading period	= "D" Campus Citizenship Grade
0 - 59 merits remaining at the end of the grading period	= "F" Campus Citizenship Grade

Each quarter, (Quarter 1), (Quarter 2), (Quarter 3), (Quarter 4), students who maintain an "A" citizenship grade for the entire Quarter may be rewarded with a special activity. These activities vary each quarter and are intended to thank the students for observing the school rules and helping to maintain a safe and productive learning environment for all students and staff on the High Desert School Campus.
